ADDENDUM

In Government Order No.FD(Spl.) 203 PEN 2012(P), dated:18-5-2016, in order portion, after Para(B), the following lines shall be inserted:-

“In case of resignation before obtaining Permanent Retirement Account Number (PRAN) any salary and salary related dues to the employee may be settled without NPS deduction by requesting HRMS through the departmental HRMS nodal officer to allow generation of salary bill without NPS deduction. However employer’s contribution equal to 10% of Basic Pay and DA thereon, has to be paid by the concerned DDO to the resigned employee by preferring a bill in CTS 8 to the concerned Treasury, by debiting HOA 2071-01-117-0-01, Non Plan voted object code 251.”

And

After Para(C), the following lines shall be inserted:-

“In case of death of NPS employee before obtaining PRAN, salary and salary related dues to the deceased employee may be settled without NPS deduction by requesting HRMS through the departmental HRMS nodal officer to allow generation of salary bill without NPS deduction. However employer’s contribution equal to 10% of Basic Pay and DA thereon, has to be paid by the concerned DDO to the dependent of deceased employee by preferring a bill in CTS 8 to the concerned Treasury, by debiting HOA 2071-01-117-0-001, Non Plan voted object code 251.”

In Annexure to the above read G.O., the following lines shall be inserted:-

Inclusion to Para No.8:-

j. In the absence of nomination by the deceased employee in CRA or if a person other than nominee is submitting the claim on basis of Survival Certificate (Issued by Tahsildar) the claimant should submit indemnity bond in Rs.100/- stamp paper along with ID and Address Proof duly attested by DDO. And all other legal heirs who are not submitting claim, must submit relinquishment deed in Rs.100/- stamp paper along with ID and Address Proof duly attested by DDO.


k. In case of superannuation if accumulated amount in the PRAN account is less than or equal to two lakhs(one lakh in case of resignation) Employee has to submit request cum under taking form for withdrawal of entire amount from the PRAN account.

1. In case of death while in service the entire accumulated amount in the PRAN account of the employee will be settled to the nominee of the deceased employee in one lumpsum, provided request cum under taking form for withdrawal of entire amount from the PRAN account is submitted.

Inclusion to Para No.18:-

If the deceased employee was allotted PRAN on softcopy basis (Non IRA PRAN) Annexure-1 form should be submitted along with the withdrawal proposal by the DDO.
