Subject : **Composition of State Civil Services under different Groups-Revision of-**

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 91 SRP (CSC) 81

DATED 27TH MARCH, 1982.

PREAMBLE :

According to sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of the Karnataka Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1957, the Civil Services of the State of Karnataka have been classified under four Groups, namely, Group A, Group B, Group C and Group D. The posts which come under each of the said Groups have been specified in sub-rule (3) of the said rule. Consequent on introduction of new scales of pay with effect from 1st January 1982, it is considered necessary to revise the composition of these groups.

ORDER

Government are pleased to order that with effect from 1st January 1982 the existing composition of State Civil Services, Group A, Group B, Group C and Group D shall be revised as below :-

- (a) State Civil Services Group A shall consist of posts carrying the scales of pay of Rs. 1200-2175 and above;
- (b) State Civil Services Group B shall consist of posts carrying the scales of pay of Rs. 920-1725 and above, but below the scale of pay of Rs. 1200-2175.
- (c) State Civil Services Group C shall consist of posts carrying the scales of pay above the scale of pay of Rs. 390-550 and posts for the appointment to which any academic, technical or professional qualifications have been prescribed but other than the posts

specified in schedule IV of the Karnataka Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1957; and

- (d) State Civil Services Group D shall consist of posts specified in Schedule IV of the aforesaid rules and the posts carrying the scale of pay of Rs. 390-550.

2 For the purposes of this order, "Scale of pay" means the revised scale of pay prescribed in respect of various posts in the Karnataka Civil services (Revised Pay) rules, 1982.

3 Necessary amendments to the Karnataka Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1957 will be issued separately.
