### **Preamble:-**

In the Govt.Order dated 24.12.2009 read at (1) above the 2006 revised UGC pay scales have been extended to the teaching and equivalent cadres of Government Universities and Aided Colleges.

In the Govt.Order dated 24.03.2010 read at (2) above the 2006 revised UGC/ICAR pay scales have been extended to the teaching cadre of the State Universities of Agriculture and Horticulture.

In the Govt.Order dated 24.06.2010 read at (3) above the pay scales of Judicial Officers drawing pay in the FNJPC Pay Scales, have been revised.

Due to the revision of UGC/ ICAR / FNJPC Pay Scales as above w.e.f. 1.1.2006, government has examined to regularise the rates of D.A w.e.f. 1.1.2006 to the teaching and equivalent cadres/Judicial Officers who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the 2006 UGC/ ICAR /FNJPC scales of pay and who retired or died while in service on or after 1.1.2006 and has orderd as below:-

Government is pleased to regularise the rates of dearness allowance to the teaching and equivalent cadres and Judicial Officers who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the 2006 UGC/ICAR/FNJPC

scales of pay and who retired or died while in service on or after 01.01.2006 as below:

<u>Date</u>	<u>Rate of D.A</u>
01.01.2006	No D.A
01.07.2006	02% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.01.2007	06% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.07.2007	09% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.01.2008	12% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.07.2008	16% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.01.2009	22% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.07.2009	27% of Basic Pension/Family Pension
01.01.2010	35% of Basic Pension/Family Pension

Further Government is pleased to sanction w.e.f. 1.7.2010 increase in the rate of D.A. from 35% to 45% of the basic pension/family pension to the teaching and equivalent cadres/Judicial Officers who were drawing immediately pay in the 2006 revised UGC/ICAR/FNJPC scales of pay and who retired on or after 1.1.2006 and family pensioner.

The increase in D.A. admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.

The payment on account of the increase in D.A as per this order involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.
