Sub : Constitution of State Level Debarment Committee for consideration of Debarment of bidder or contractor or supplier – Reg.

Ref : Rule 26 of Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2000.


In exercise of the provisions contained under Rule 26B of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2000, Government of Karnataka hereby constitutes the State Level Debarment Committee to consider the proposals for Debarring bidder or contractor or supplier and to take a decision thereof as below;

(1)	The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Public Works Department	: Chairman
(2)	The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Water Resources Department	: Member
(3)	The Additional Chief Secretary/Secretary to Government, Urban Development Department	: Member
(4)	The Principal Secretary to Government, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department	: Member
(5)	The Special Officer and Ex-officio Joint Secretary to Government (ZP)	: Member
(6)	The Project Director, DPAR, e-Governance (e-Proc.),	: Member
(7)	Representative of Law Department not below the rank of Deputy Secretary	: Member
(8)	The Representative of the Department proposing Debarment	: Special Invitee
(9)	The Deputy Secretary to Government Public Works Department (C&B)	: Member Secretary

The Department proposing the debarment of any tenderer or contractor or supplier shall submit the proposal to the State Level Debarment Committee immediately but before 15 days from the receipt of the information regarding the debarment of such tenderer or contractor or supplier.

The Officer, authorized by the concerned Procurement Entity shall attend and furnish the details to the State Level Debarment Committee. The State Level Debarment Committee so constituted above make recommendation to the State Government after duly following the procedure laid down in the Rules.
