Preamble:-

1. The rates of dearness allowance admissible to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners have been raised from 17.50% to 22.75% of basic pension/family pension with effect from 1.1.2008 vide Government Order read at (1) above . It has been mentioned that the increase in the rates of dearness allowance sanctioned thereon shall not be applicable to pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the UGC/AICTE/ ICAR scales of pay and who retired on or after 1st July 2005 and that separate order will be issued in respect of those pensioners.

2. . The rates of D.A. payable to the teaching staff librarians, and physical education staff of government and aided educational institutions and universities who are in receipt of UGC/AICTE/ICAR Rules of pay has been revised, w.e.f. 1st July 2007 from 85% to 91% vide Government Order read at (2) above.

3. The rates of D.A. payable to the teaching staff librarians, and physical education staff of government and aided educational institutions and universities who are in receipt of UGC/AICTE/ICAR Rules of pay has been revised, w.e.f. 1.1.2008 from 91% to 97% vide Government Order read at (3) above.

4. Therefore the issue regarding to revision of the rates of dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.01.2008 to pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the UGC/AICTE /ICAR scales of pay and who



Government are pleased to sanction increase in the rates of dearness allowance , from 91% to 97% of the basic pension/family pension with effect from 1st January 2008 to pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the UGC/AICTE /ICAR scales of pay and who retired on or after 1st July 2005.

2. The payment on account of the increase in dearness allowance as per this order involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.
