Sub: Automatic release of withheld DCRG after six months from the date of retirement – revision of amount to be withheld.

The above Govt. Order referred to at Sl.No: (1) above provides for withholding of 10% of DCRG or Rs.1000/- whichever is less if no information about dues from the Head of the Office in respect of Non-Gazetted (C & D) officials and or the Head of the Department in respect of Gazetted Officers (A & B) by the Accountant General for a period of 6 months from the date of their retirement . If no information about specific amount of recovery to be made from DCRG is received by Accountant General within the above period of 6 months, he shall automatically release the withheld amount after recovering the departmental dues already intimated and also the dues recoverable as per his books if any.

In partial modification of the above provisions, government have revised the limit of DCRG with immediate effect to 10% or Rs.10,000 of DCRG whichever is less. Accordingly the Accountant General shall start withholding 10% of the DCRG or Rs.10,000/- whichever is less in cases of Govt. servants where he has not been informed by Heads of Depts. and

others of the dues to be recovered from them from now onwards. Other provisions of O.M. dated 23.9.85 remain unaltered.
