Preamble:

In the Government order read at (1) above, certain powers have been delegated to the Secretaries of the Administrative Departments of Government. In the Government Order read at (2) above among other modifications to certain items of Government Order No.FD 1 TFP 96 dated: 10.07.1996, Item No.49 has been modified as follows:

“Excess over original estimate or revised estimate upto 25% over original estimate or Rs.50.00 lakhs whichever is lower”.

In para 13 of the Government Order read at (3) above, the Secretaries to Government of Administrative Departments have been delegated with powers to accord administrative approval for estimates of works and procurement of goods and services upto Rs.5.00 crores presuming the concurrence of Finance Department. Therefore, it has been considered necessary to revise the power of approving excess over the original estimate or revised estimate under item No.49 and hence this order.
