Sub: Delegation of enhanced Financial Powers to Public Works and Water Resources Department Officers revision – reg.

Preamble:

In the Government orders cited above, certain Financial Powers to the officers of the Public Works and Water Resources Departments were delegated with a view to securing expeditions discharge of the duties. These powers have not been revised / enhanced for a long time. In view of the changed circumstances and the requirement of the speedy execution of works, Public Works Department has sent a proposal for the consideration of the Government, to revise the delegation of enhanced financial powers.

The powers delegated to various officers of the Public Works and Water Resources Departments for items (1), (2) & (3) in the Government Orders read above are reproduced as below:



After careful consideration of the proposal of the Public Works Department and taking into account the increased cost in labour, material and with the objective of securing speedy and efficient execution of works, Government has decided to revise the existing enhanced Financial Powers of various level of officers in the Departments of Public Works, Water Resources and Minor Irrigation & Ground Water Development in respect of items (1), (2) and (3) as detailed below:
