Time-bound Advancement Exercise of option to continue in the scale of pay of lower post-Extension of time-limit.

**Government Order No.FD 50 SRP 87,
Bangalore, Dated the 24th June 1987.**

In Official Memorandum No.FD 60 SRP 84, dated 11-12-1985, it was clarified that a Government servant who desired to continue in the scale of pay of the lower post until he becomes eligible for the selection time-scale of pay under the scheme of Time-bound Advancement should give an option in writing to that effect to the Appointing Authority within two months from the date of promotion or from the date of issue of the Official Memorandum. In Government Order No's. FD 32 SRP 86, dated 18-4-86, and FD 53 SRP 86 dated 26-8-1986, the time limit for giving option was further extended upto 30-6-1986 and 31-10-1986, respectively. Representations have been received from the employees for extending this time-limit further.

Government are now pleased to extend the time-limit for giving option by Government servants who have already been promoted to higher posts for a further period upto 31-12-1987.

The Heads of Departments should bring the contents of these orders to the notice of all concerned immediately. It should be made clear to them that no further extension of time limit would be granted.
